



UNDERGRADUATE HONOR SYTEM APPLICATION- HEARING PANEL MEMBER

Purpose:

Live out Ut Prosim through involvement with the Undergraduate Honor System. The Undergraduate Honor System is a student led system, designed to cultivate a culture of honor and integrity on campus. Becoming involved with the Undergraduate Honor System allows students to develop and utilize elite and social leadership skills such as time management, conflict management and public speaking. Students are also able to interact with administrators and faculty. These skills are highly sought-after by potential and future employees.

Hearing Panel Members partake in the Hokie tradition by serving on hearing panels throughout the semester. Panel members are involved in determining whether a student is responsible for a violation of the honor code and for recommending appropriate sanctions in cases where students are found responsible. Panel members are also expected to maintain complete confidentiality of all information and outcomes of Honor Code proceedings. Students who serve in this position are expected to serve 3-4 times per semester and are able to pick the hearing dates and times that their schedule permits. Hearing panel members will be required to attend training.

Eligibility:

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Maintain an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher from the date of application through the 2017-18 academic year.
- 2) Must be in good academic and disciplinary standing.
- 3) Must be willing to serve on at least 3-4 hearing panels per semester.
- 4) Must be willing to attend the required training that occurs early in the fall semester (Dates TBA).
- 5) Be committed to maintaining confidentiality of all facets of hearing panels.

Application Deadline:

By submitting the following information, you will be considered for the position of Hearing Panel Member within the Office of Undergraduate Academic Integrity. Please fill out the application and return it to 104 Hillcrest Hall or via email at honorsys@vt.edu. The application must be submitted no later than **5:00pm on Monday, February 27th**.

If selected for further consideration, applicants will be called for an in-person interview. These interviews will take place in early to mid-March.
